Membership update: 664 letters mailed to solicit membership after last year's (2020) dues holiday. 32 percent overall returned by post office due to no mailbox or seasonal residency. People who volunteered to hand deliver returned letters included: John and Patty Matra, Woody and Michelle Berringer, Mike and Arlene Libonati and Ann Riley.

Current membership status 85 members paid via the website and 25 via check for a total of 110 members. We now have wifi at the clubhouse. Password 1942aLa@80. This password will be changed from time to time. Wifi is costing about \$60 per month.

The ALD budget passed and allowed for the usual \$8,000 stipend for ALA. John is working with Frank Holsi (ALD President) on a welcome packet for new residents to help clarify what the ALD v. the ALA does.

In addition, John spoke of possible clubhouse improvements including the update of the 2nd bathroom and ceiling which is dependent on the status of the current heating system. This was in response to Sue Matyszyk's question.
